

Call for Applications:

Young Statisticians Session at the CEN 2026

The **Young Statisticians Session (YSS)** can be seen as a prestigious conference rehearsal. As a chosen Young Statistician, you will present your research in English in a friendly atmosphere with the opportunity to get feedback on your presentation (performance, content, layout, etc.). The chosen Young Statisticians receive a certificate and are invited to the conference dinner. Furthermore, their conference fee will be waived. Additional funding may become available but cannot be guaranteed at that point.

Who should apply?

- Students at the end of their bachelor's or master's studies or
- Post-graduate students / PhD students in an early phase

Your presentation should preferably cover the topic of your bachelor's or master's thesis. It can also include work in progress if no final research results are yet obtained.

Application and selection procedure

Please send your abstract in line with the <u>general conference guidelines</u> (maximum 400 words, including references but excluding title and authors), and a short CV in tabular form. Please also indicate whether this is the topic of your Bachelor's / Master's / PhD thesis.

The YSS committee of the CEN will review all submissions. You will be notified about the decision on your abstract by **November 20**, before the regular CEN submission deadline. If your abstract is not selected for the YSS, you will have the opportunity to resubmit your contribution following the standard conference procedure.
